



- It indicates strengths, weakness and competencies in early development so that caregivers and professionals can properly plan for the child's future

Bayley-III Overview

Format

Core battery of five subtests-cognitive, language, motor, social-emotional, and adaptive behavior

Ages

I to 42 months

Scores

Scaled score for each subtest, standard scores, age equivalents, and percentile growth scores

Administration

30 to 90 minutes (depending upon age of child)

The Bayley Scales of Infant and Toddler Development is used to identify deficits in young children across five major developmental domains:

Language

Receptive and expressive language subtests

Adaptive Behavior Communication, Self-care, self-direction

Motor

Fine motor and gross motor subtests

Cognitive

Visual preference, attention, memory, sensorimotor, exploration, manipulation and concept formation

Social-emotional

Communicating needs, self-regulation using emotional signals
